Scholarship requirements:

1. Student must be enrolled in a major within the field of family and consumer sciences/ human ecology at a baccalaureate granting institution in Kansas.
2. Student must currently hold student membership to the [American Association of Family & Consumer Sciences](#) or have submitted application for membership by the application deadline of February 1st.
3. **Deadline for application will be February 1st** of each year for students who will have completed 60 credit hours by the end of the current spring semester. The scholarship amount is \$500 per semester. (\$1000 for first academic year following selection)
4. One additional semester scholarship will be available to each selected student if she or he maintains a minimum overall grade point average of 3.0 for the previous semester. It is the student's responsibility to submit a copy of their transcript to the KAFCS Foundation by June 1 following the year in which the initial scholarship was received. This means that an individual student may receive a total of up to \$1500 in scholarship support from the KAFCS Foundation.
5. Each year, one additional scholarship will be given to a Kansas State University student and one additional scholarship to a Pittsburg State University student. In the event that for any one year, no acceptable applications are received from KSU or PSU, two students from the same institution may be selected.
